Registration:

There will be a limit of 30 boats allowed to register. Registration will be on a 'first received – first registered' basis. If more than 30 registrations are received, a waiting list will be established. We will be using the AMYA online registration, so please register at <https://form.jotform.com/81937651714968>. You can also get to the link from the event website, where we will also be listing all registered participants.

Race Format:

Scoring will be the low point system for fleet racing. Throw outs will be allowed (as defined in the Sailing Instructions). If more than 15 boats attend, then the Odd/Even Heat system will be used.

Rules:

The regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020* as modified by Appendix E *RC Boat Racing Rules*, by the SeaWind Class Rules, and by the Sailing Instructions for this event.

Eligibility:

Any owner of a SeaWind yacht registered with the SeaWind Class Owners Association who is also a current member of AMYA or his/her appropriate national authority may participate.

Inspection:

All boats will be subject to inspection, including weighing, before or at any time during the regatta in order to verify compliance with the SeaWind Class Rules.

Frequency Assignments:

Every effort will be made to assign your primary frequency. If a conflict arises, frequencies will be allocated on a "first come – first served" basis. If an alternative channel is required, the entrant will be notified as soon as possible.

Awards:

Gold chevrons are supplied by the AMYA for the first three places. Trophies will be awarded for at least the top 20% of the fleet.

Lunches:

Lunches will be included in the entry fee for both Saturday and Sunday. Additional lunches for guests can be ordered.

Accommodations:

Local hotels include the Ramada Inn at 1250 Halyard Dr., the Holiday Inn Express at 2761 Evergreen Ave, or the Hampton Inn at 800 Stillwater Rd.

Entry:

The entry deadline will be September 16th, or when 30 registrations have been received. The entry fee will be \$50 and must be submitted with the entry form. Included in the fee is the racing, trophies, lunch for both days, assorted snacks and drinks, and other items. Registrations received by September 1st will receive an early bird discount of \$10.

Additional Information:

As registrations are received, the website will be updated to include the list of participants with their name, home town, and frequency assignment.

A no host dinner is planned for Saturday evening. Details to be announced later.
